#### **Harnessing Renewable Energy**

Our global headquarters began its solar journey in **February 2012**, with Phase One installation — the first project in Missouri to utilize 335-watt "Lifeline Solar" monocrystalline panels. This provided **30% of our facility's energy needs**.

- Phase Two (2019): Doubled our solar panel capacity, cutting electrical usage by nearly 70%.
- **Phase Three (2022):** Delivered even more double-digit savings, bringing us closer to full renewable energy coverage.

Today, we are proud to say we have the capability to generate enough solar power to sustain operations 24/7/365.



### **Energy Efficiency**

In **2016**, we installed more than **1,000 LED bulbs** across our facilities. Our 2022 expansion used only LED fixtures, ensuring consistent energy savings and efficiency. LED lighting not only consumes less energy and lasts longer but also eliminates hazardous materials such as mercury — making it safer for people and the environment.



#### **Certified Environmental Management**

In **2025**, Walker Products achieved **ISO 14001 Certification**, the internationally recognized standard for Environmental Management Systems. Certified by Bureau Veritas, this recognition covers both our Pacific, MO and Grand Junction, CO sites, validating our efforts in:

- Designing, developing, manufacturing, and distributing oxygen sensors, exhaust gas temperature sensors, and engine system components.
- Producing custom gaskets, stampings, assemblies, and ignition products.

This certification demonstrates our commitment to ongoing environmental stewardship, regulatory compliance, and continuous improvement.

### **Recycling & Waste Reduction**

Through a comprehensive recycling program, we divert paper, plastics, glass, metal, cardboard, wood products, and even waste oils from landfills.
